Job Summary:

The ART Clinician is in charge of providing initial ART Clinical care on a day-to-day basis at the outpost and making referrals to the institution for continuum HIV care and treatment services. She or he will collaborate with the Amref Program staff, Health Facilities (HFs), ZIHHTLP and other stakeholders.

Duties & Key Responsibilities:

- Providing AHD screening services and HTN screening to PLHIV.
- Management of Opportunistic Infections.
- Staging of HIV patients for Antiretroviral Therapy (ART) eligibility.
- Initiating patients on ART.
- Managing complications of ART.
- Initiation and monitoring of Post-Exposure Prophylaxis.
- Providing consultation to HIV-positive patients on the wards as requested.
- Maintaining accurate medical records and other data collection as required for Monitoring and evaluation within the Clinic.
- Participating in Clinic Team Meetings and assisting the site manager with strategic planning for the Clinic.
- Conduct enhanced adherence to clients including to low level viremia.
- Participate on clinic preparation in collaboration with other HF staffs.
- Performing any other duties as assigned by the supervisor.

Qualifications, Experience & Skills Required:

- At least a Diploma in Clinical Medicine from a recognized institution.
- At least three (3) years' experiences in HIV/AIDS care and treatment services.
- Ability to maintain confidentiality in all aspects.
- Experience in basic computer applications such as MS Word, Excel, Power point and internet.
- Ability to work both individually and as part of a team with minimal supervision.
